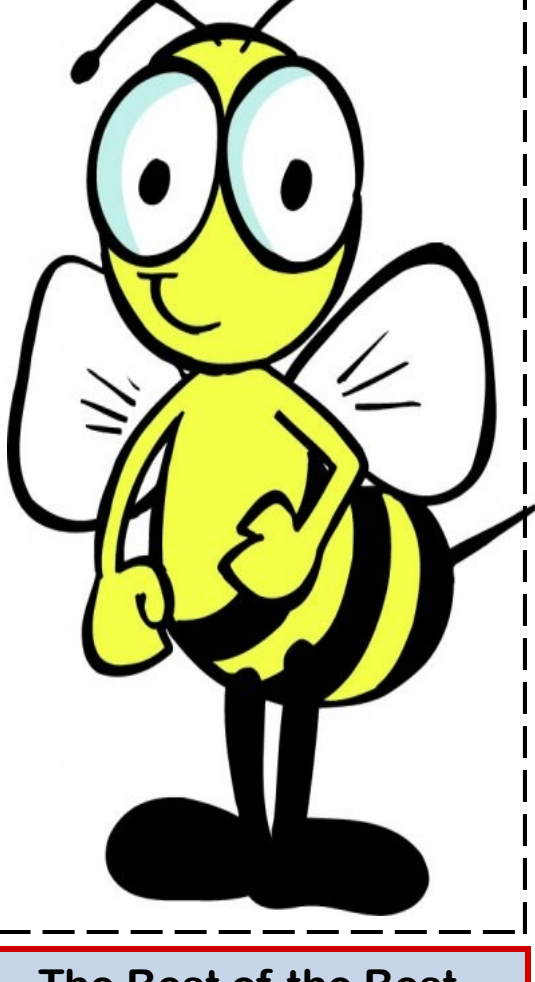

and **Project G.R.A.C.E.** handling the **assistance.**

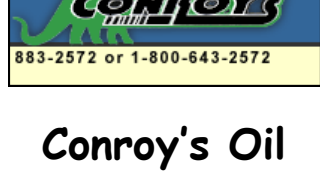


Based on program guidelines and estimated oil prices,
